Dear Parents,

As part of our continuing effort to instill in students an enjoyment of reading and to reinforce reading skills already learned, the faculty of Madison Creative Arts Academy is encouraging each student's participation in our Accelerated Reader Summer Reading Program.

The benefits of this program are many. Keeping skills sharp helps prevent the regression that often occurs during the summer. New knowledge and understanding is gained through reading a variety of books, and reading practice is the only way to improve reading.

A powerful motivator for children is to see their parents reading for pleasure. Whenever you can read at the same time as your child, you will be providing an effective role model for him/her to follow. Reading to your children, even after they can read, also motivates pleasure reading. If you remember books you enjoyed as a child, by all means suggest them. Above all, let students choose books of interest to them. Keep it fun, not a chore.

We encourage students to read books through Epic, and the public library can help with book selections. AR quizzes can be taken at home at <https://global-zone20.renaissance-go.com/welcomeportal/60461> and at the public library during the summer. Students will use the username and password used at school.

Instructions for our reading program are as follows:

1. Students in Grades 1-7 may take AR quizzes online at home and at the public library in Madison, Greenville, and Lee. If you will not be able to go the library or do not have access to a computer, use the attached sheet to record your books.
2. When school begins, each student who has read any books should bring the enclosed statement or another written statement from parents. The statement must include title, author, # of pages, type (fiction, non-fiction, biography), date finished, and parent's signature.
3. Students who participate in the program will receive special recognition upon their return.
